MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH QINTUM TECHNOLOGIES INC

On 18 June 2004, the Board of Directors of Unified Communications Holdings Limited (the "Company") had announced that its wholly-owned subsidiary, Unified Communications Sdn Bhd ("UCSB"), had signed a non-binding Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with Quintum Technologies, Inc. ("Quintum"), a company incorporated in the United States of America and a leading Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") equipment manufacturer.

Under the terms of the MOU, Quintum will deploy UCSB's UniLink SS7 Gateway (which include Unified SS7 software, the related Application Program Interface and the relevant Intel Datakinetics SS7 products) as its OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) products and to bundle to its VoIP solution for sale to its distributors and customers.

The MOU is valid for a period of six (6) months from the date of execution of the MOU, unless otherwise extended by mutual agreement between UCSB and Quintum.

As both UCSB and Quintum are currently in negotiation over the commercial terms of the said deployment, the Board of Directors of the Company wishes to announce that after due consideration, both parties have agreed that the validity period of the MOU be extended for a further period of six (6) months from 18 December 2004 to 17 June 2005 with all other terms and conditions as set out in the MOU remaining unchanged.
